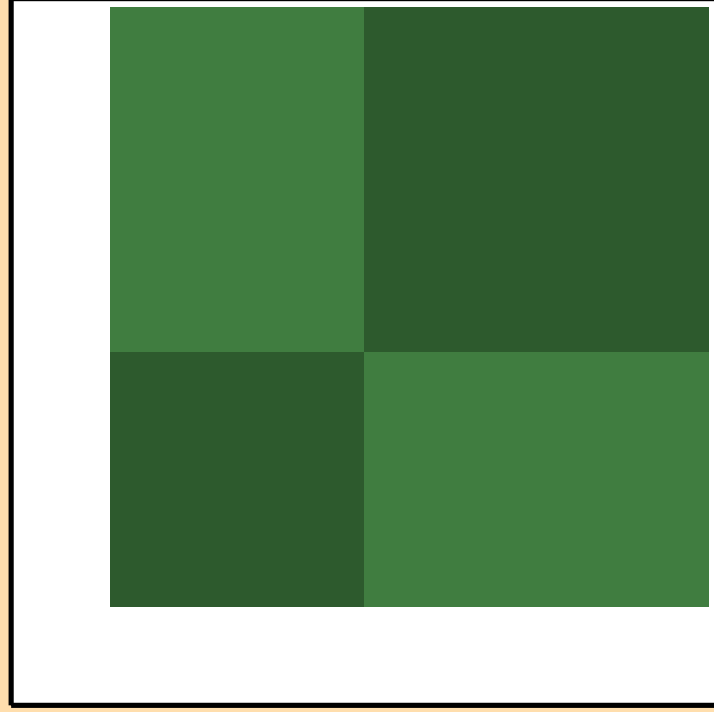
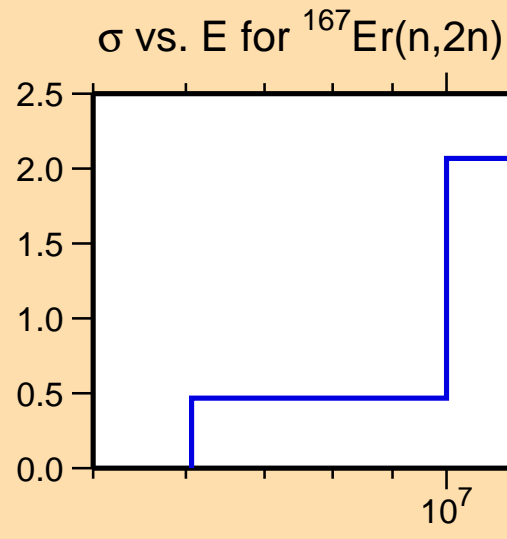


$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{167}\text{Er}(n,2n)$

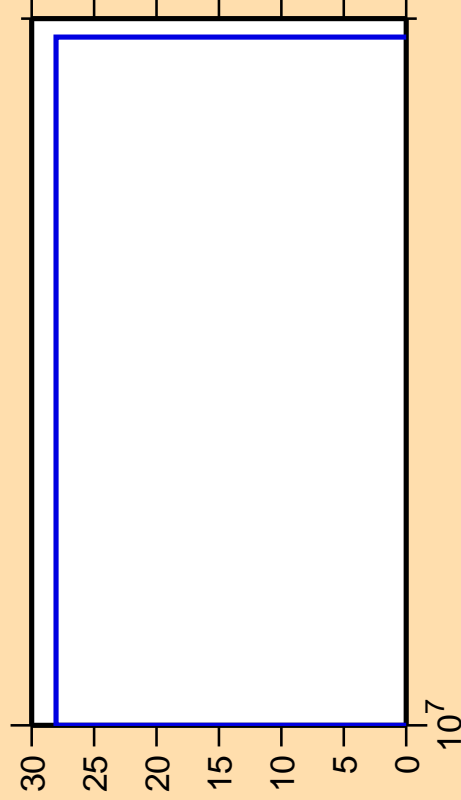
σ vs. E for $^{167}\text{Er}(n,t)$
