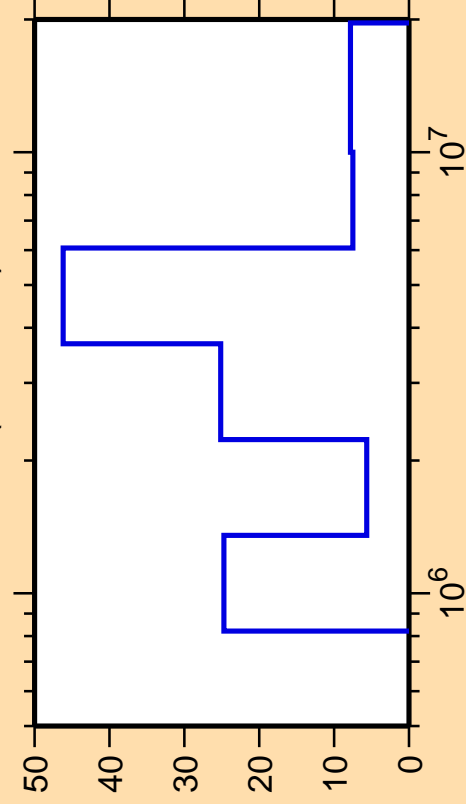
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{14}\text{C}(n,\text{tot.})$

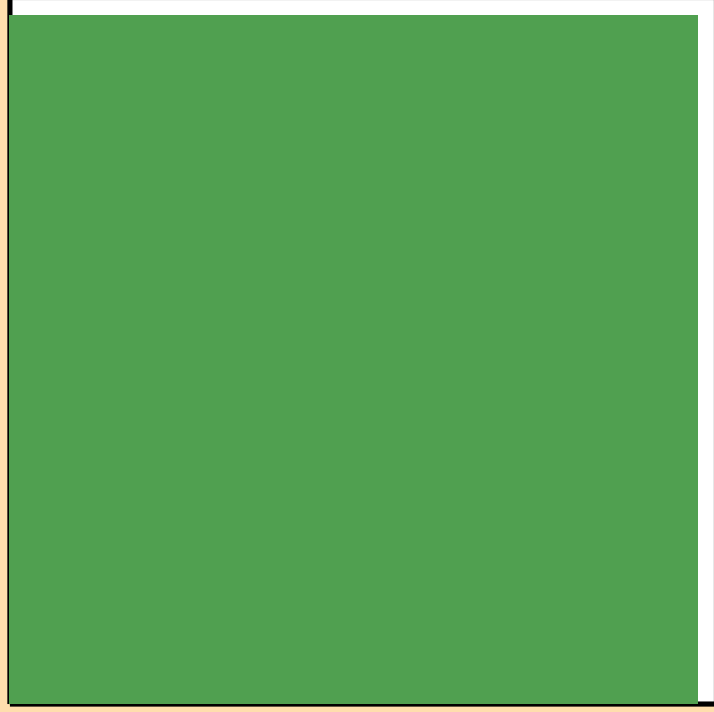
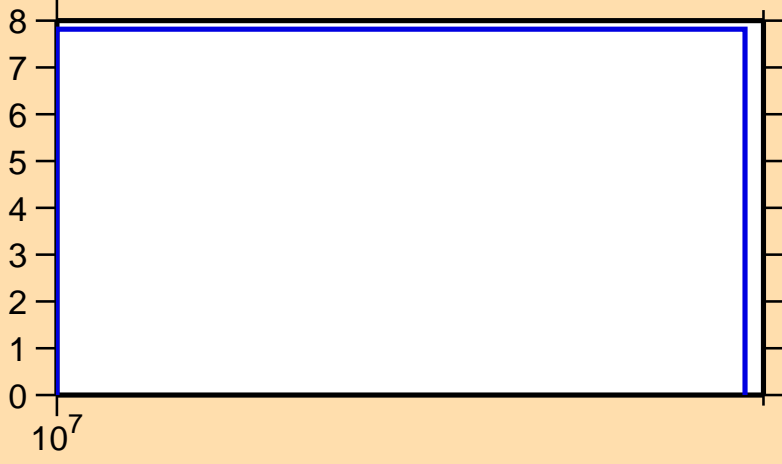
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{14}\text{C}(n,\alpha)$

$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{14}\text{C}(n,\alpha)$



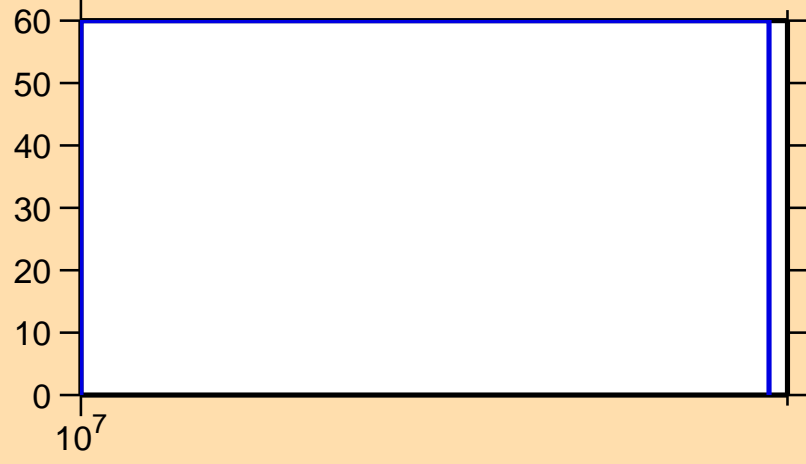
