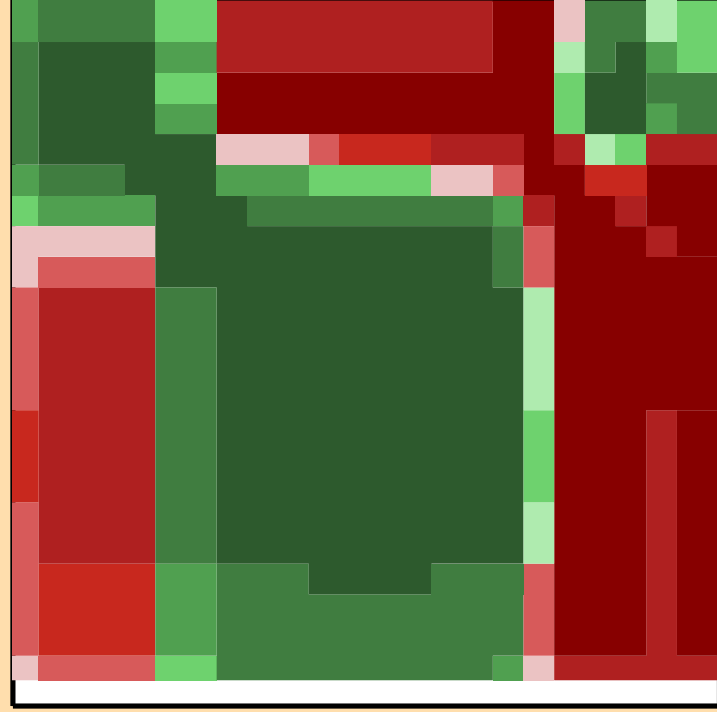
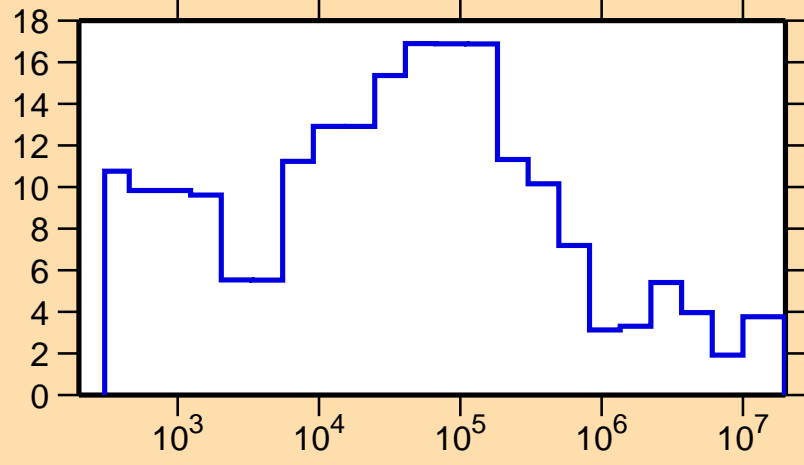
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{110}\text{Rh}(n,\text{inel.})$
