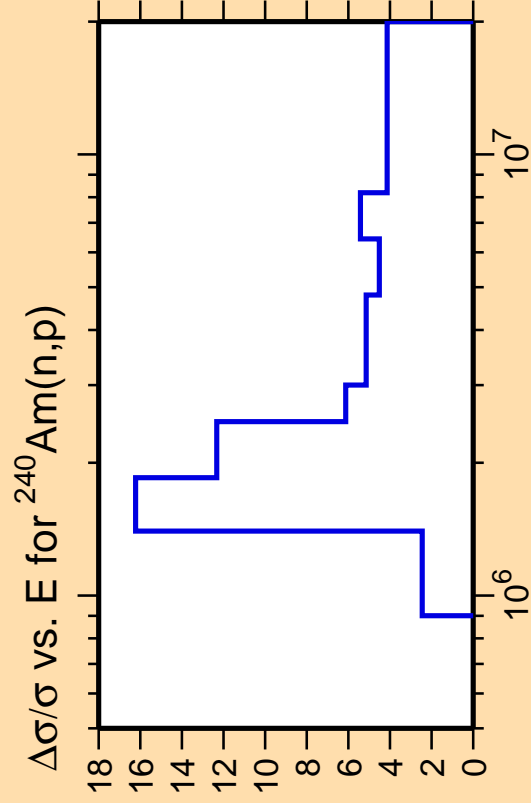
$\sigma$  vs.  $E$  for  $^{240}\text{Am}(n,\gamma)$

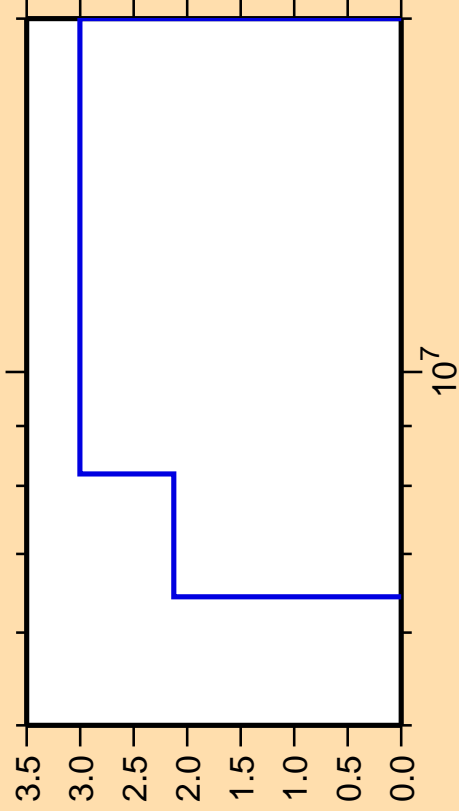
$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$  vs. E for  $^{240}\text{Am}(n,p)$
