$\Delta\sigma/\sigma$ vs. E for $^{65}\text{Cu}(n,\text{el.})$

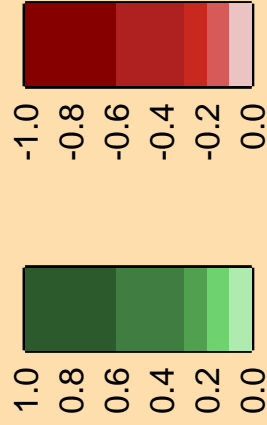

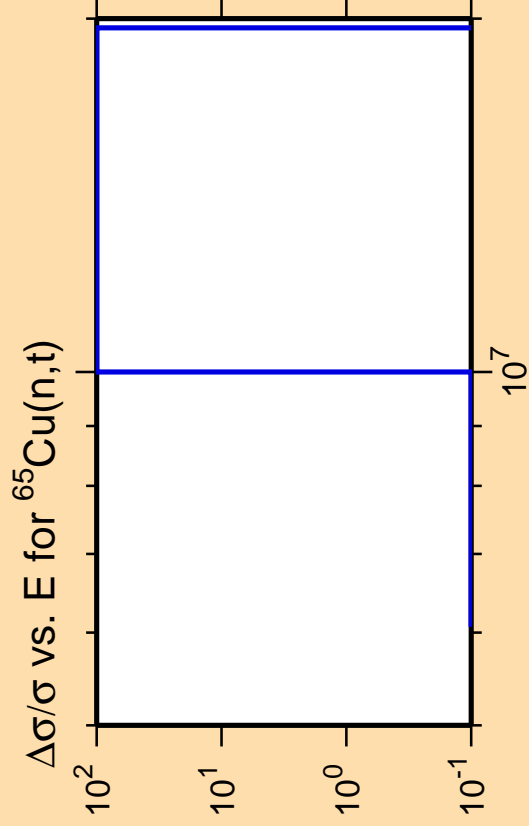


σ vs. E for $^{65}\text{Cu}(n,d)$
