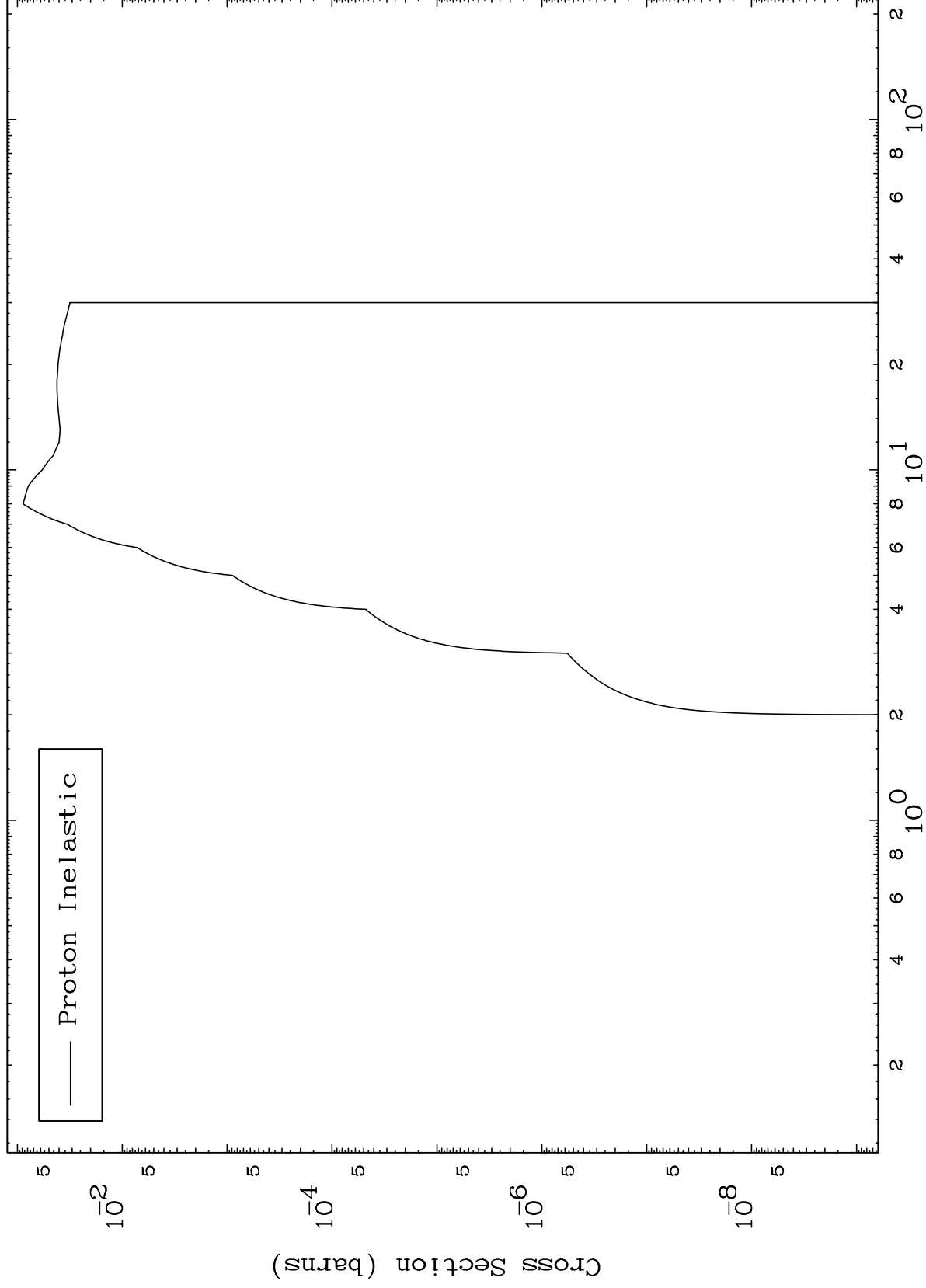

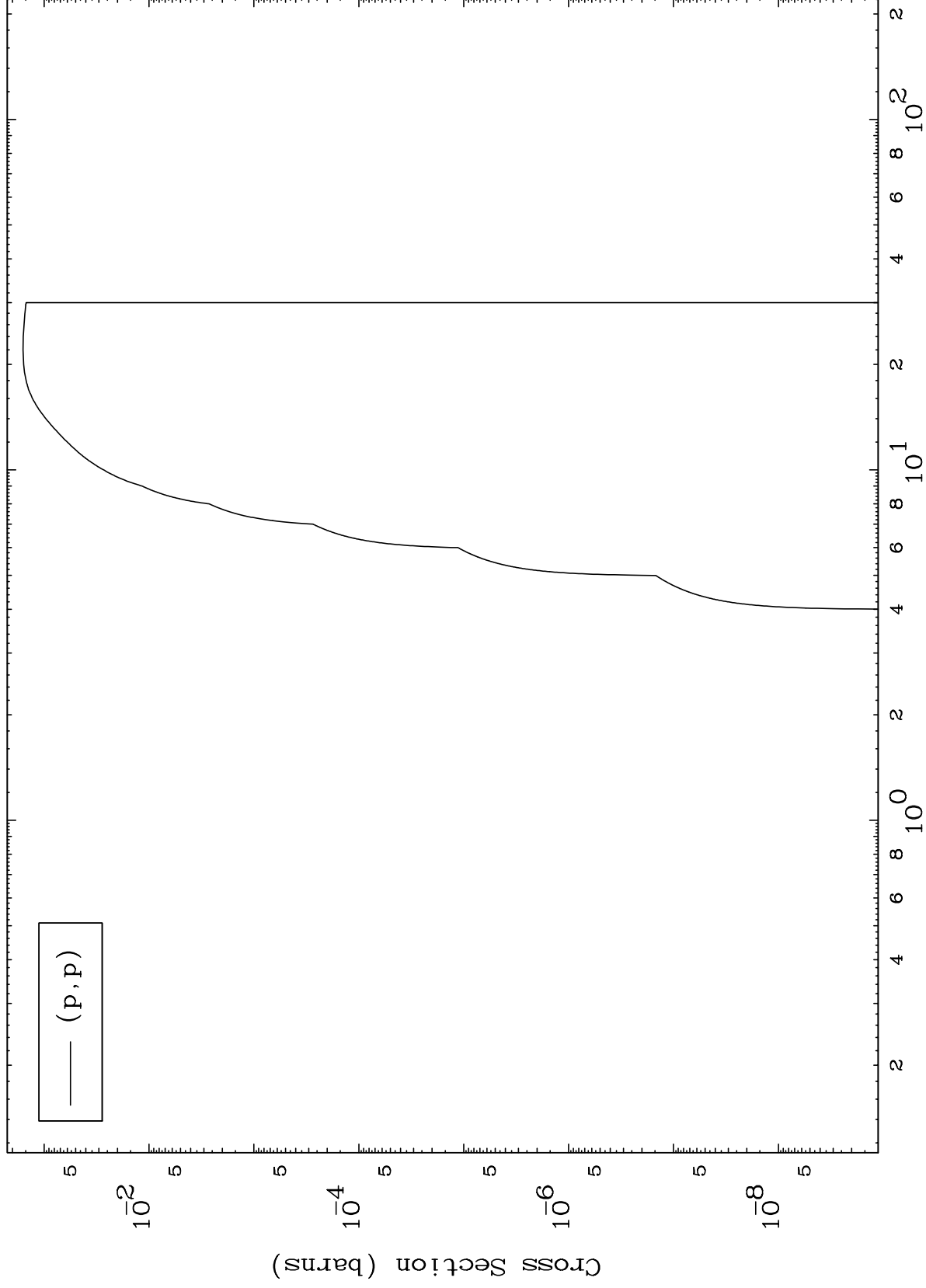

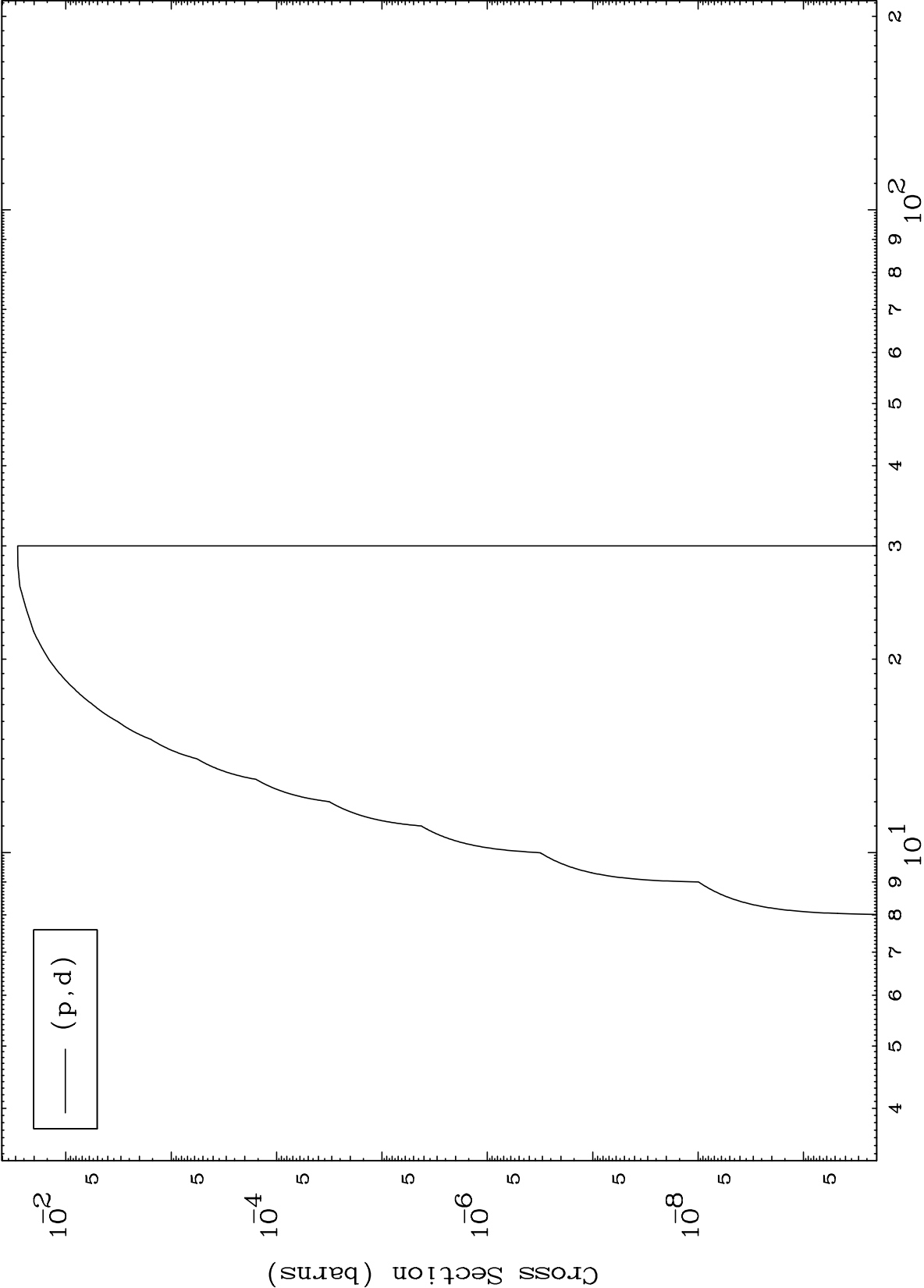

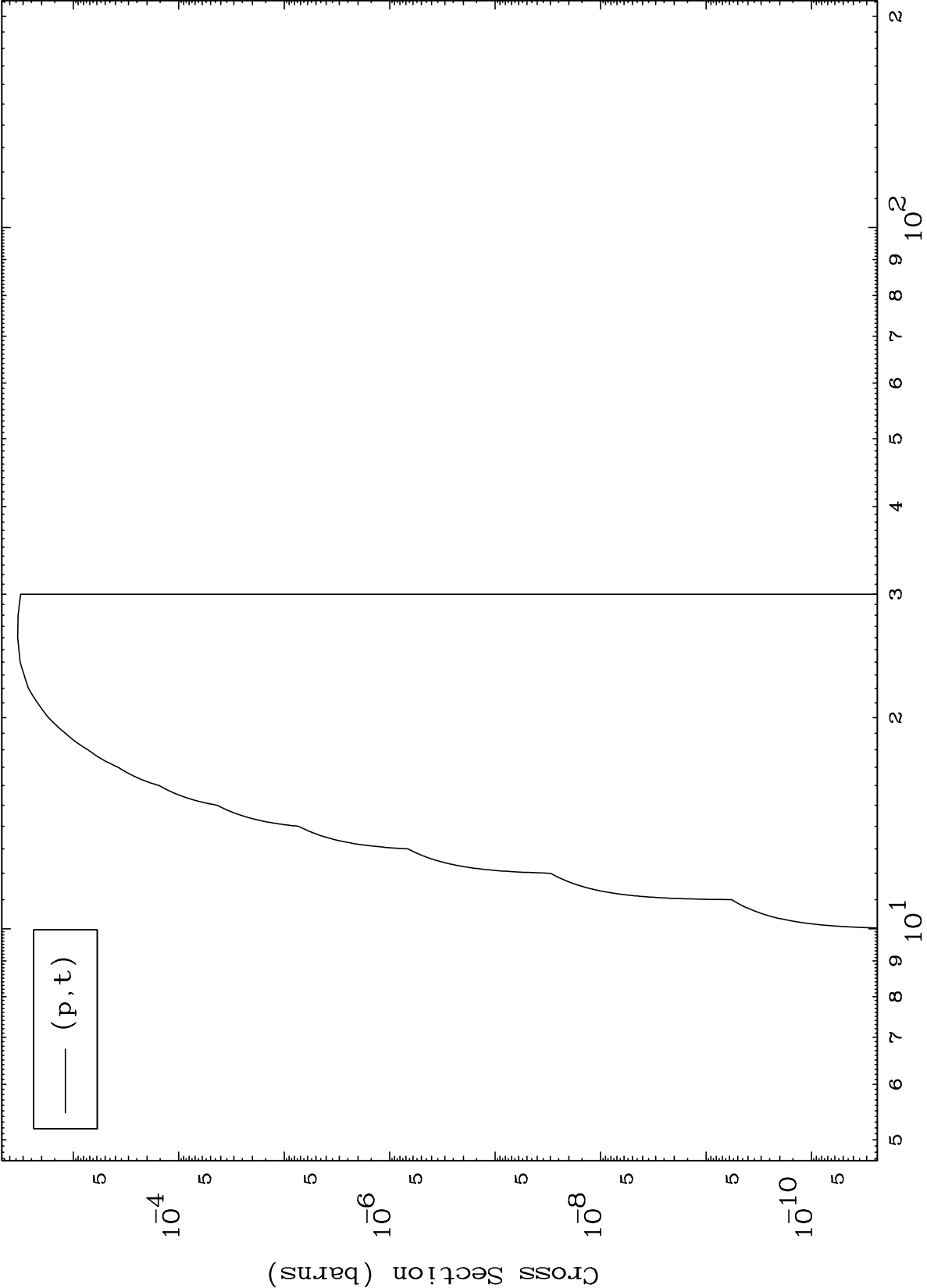

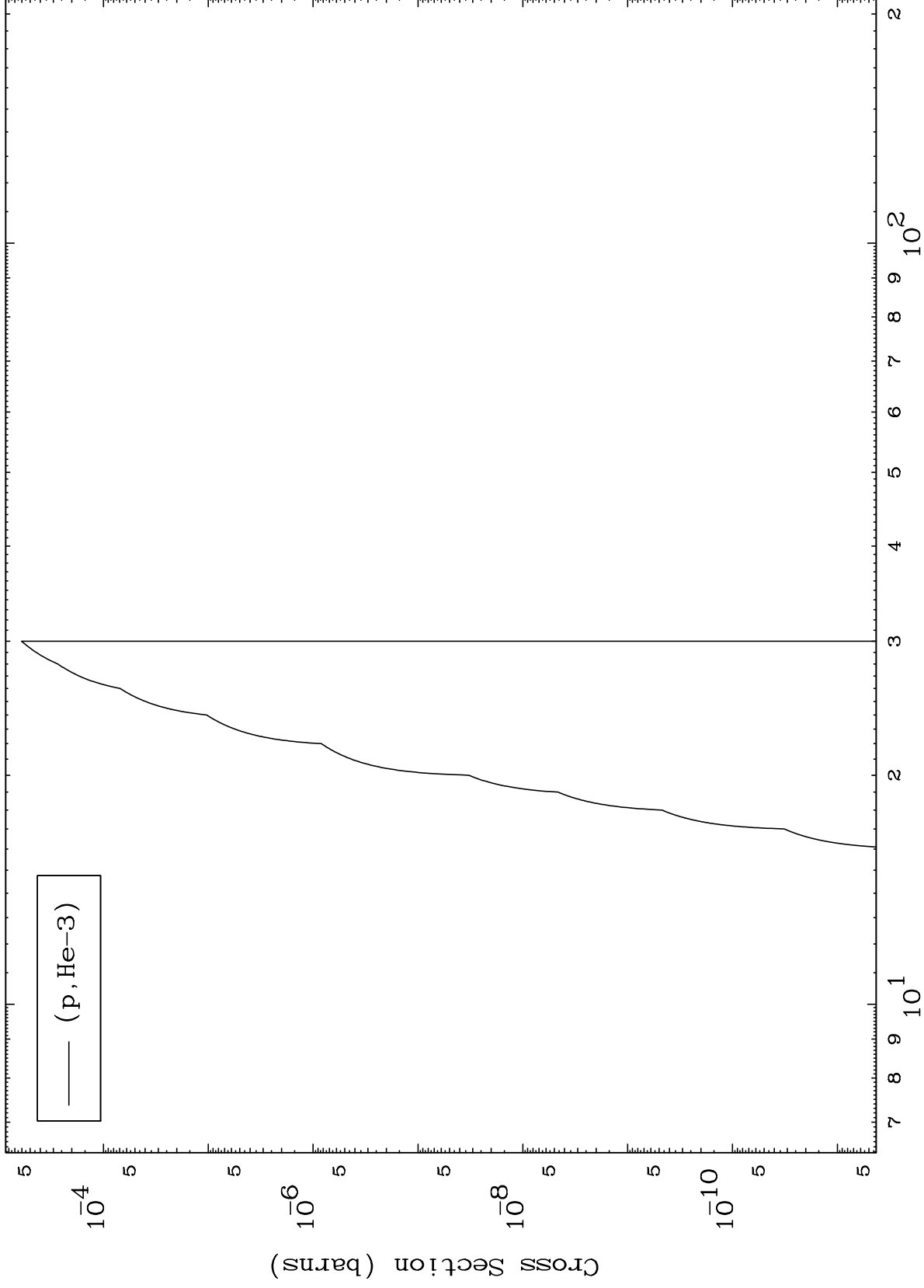

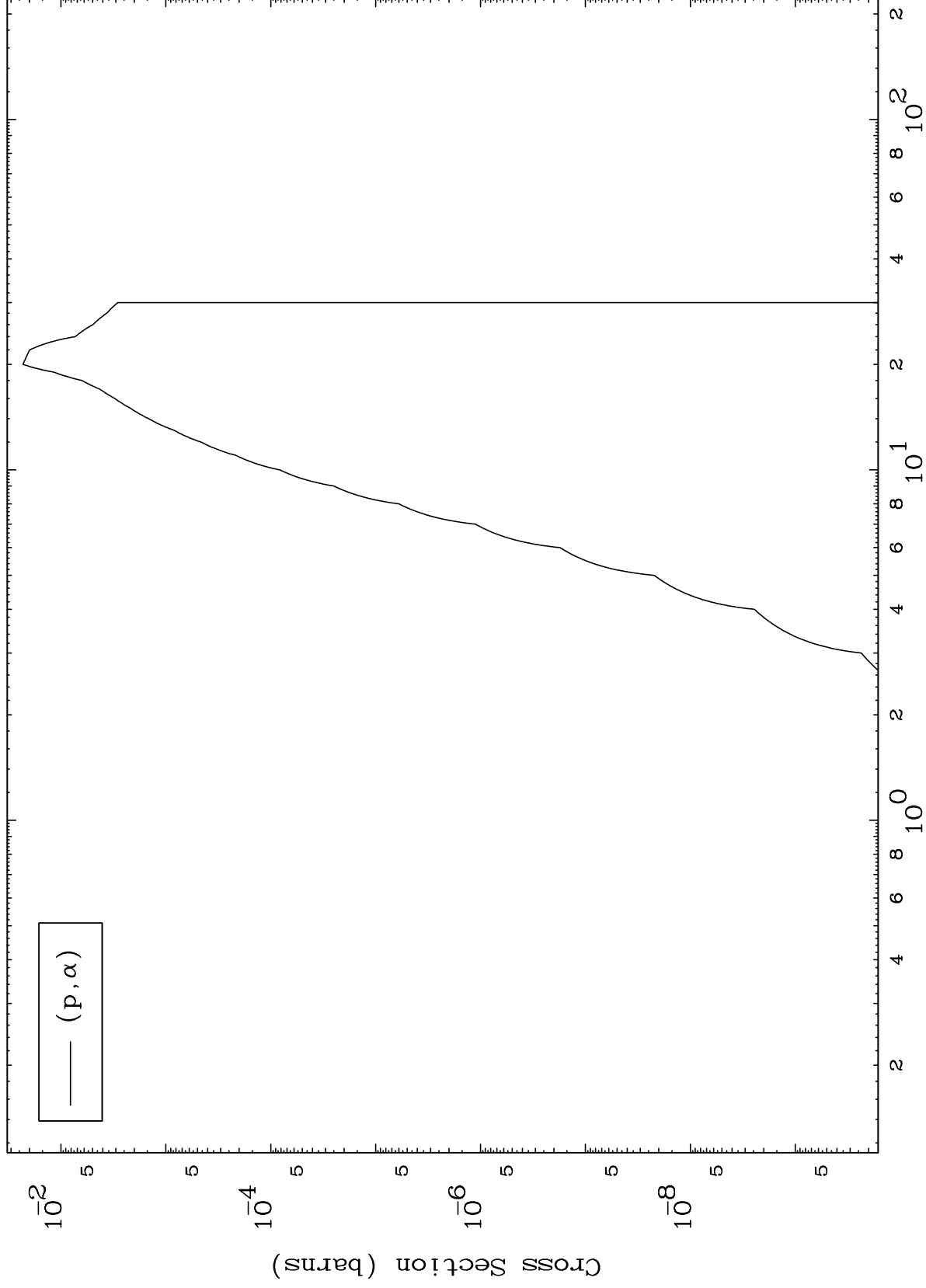

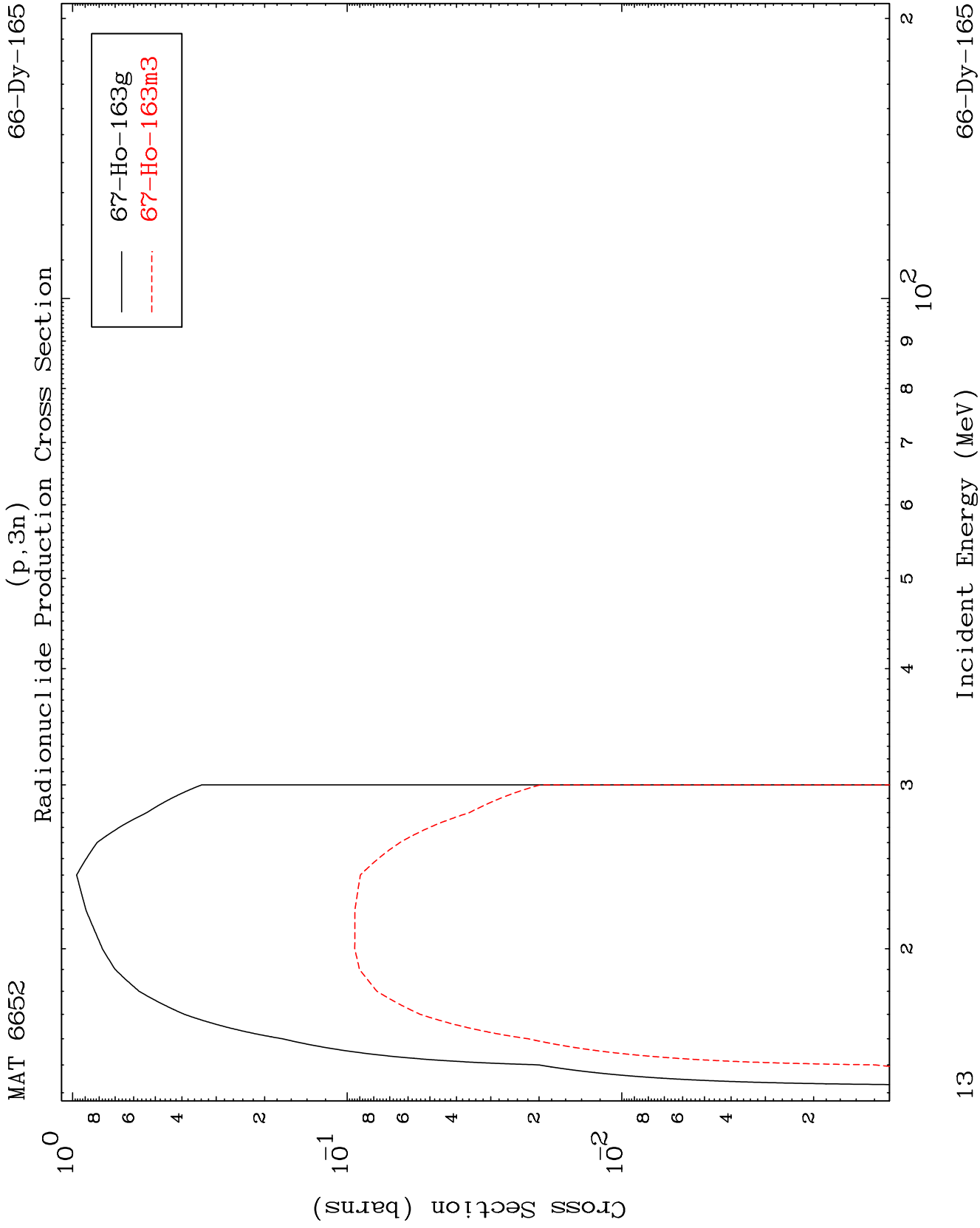
(p,2n)
Radionuclide Production Cross Section

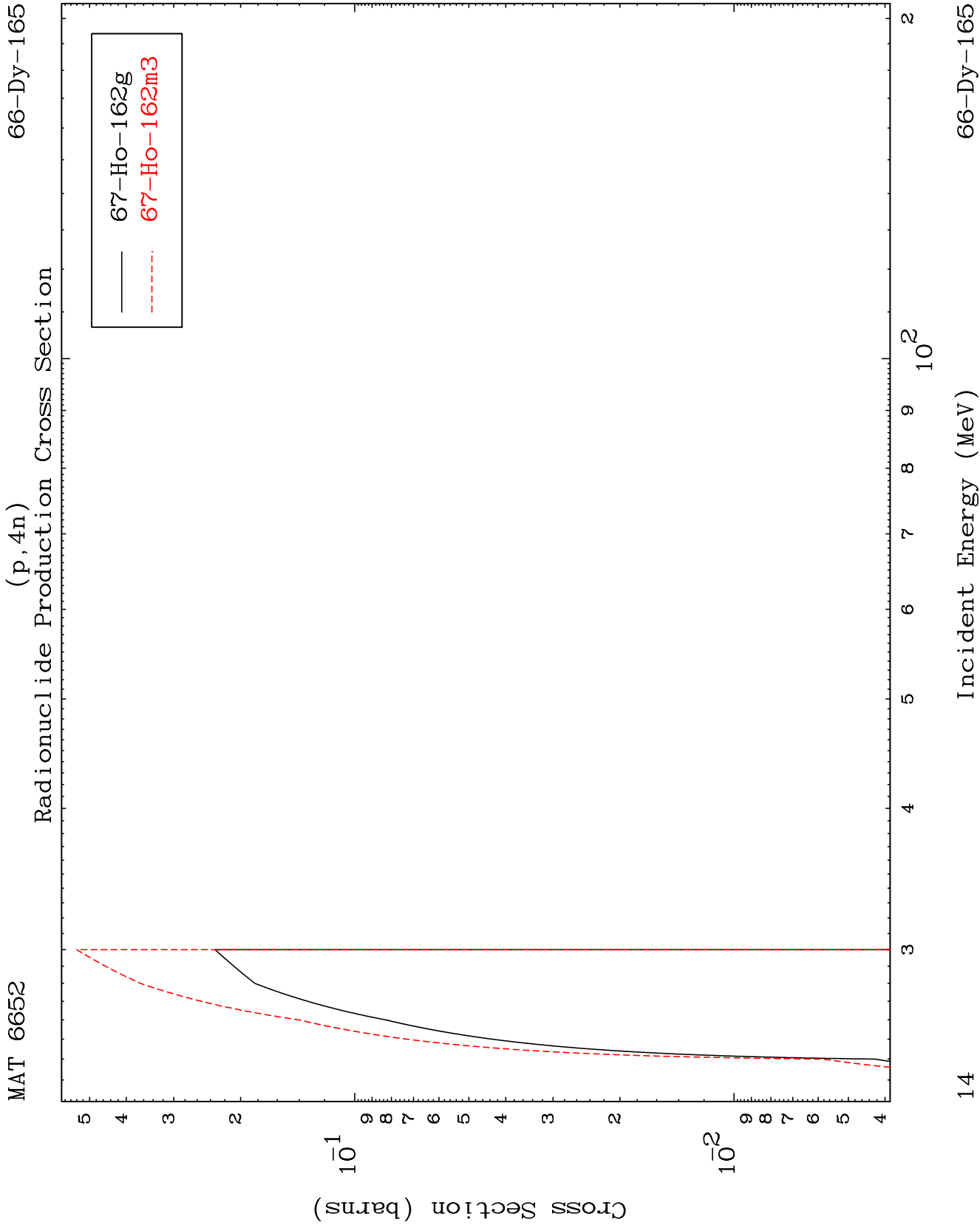

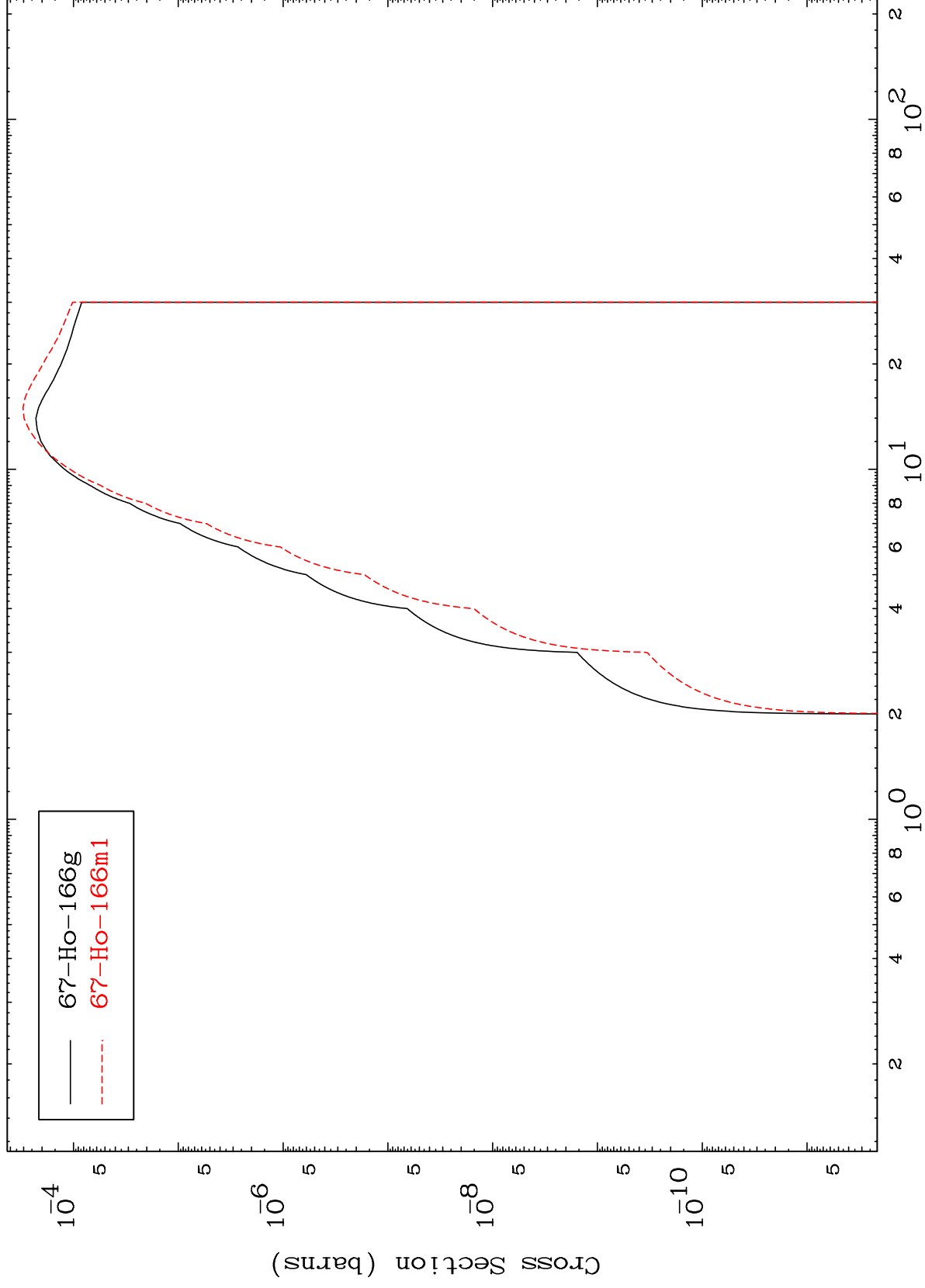
